The NSW Government has released a new <u>NSW Climate Change Policy</u> <u>Framework</u>. This policy provides important context for the government's approach to climate change. It sets two aspirational objectives:

- achieving net zero emissions by 2050
- NSW being more resilient to a changing climate.

The government has also announced a \$500 million funding package and released two draft climate change and energy savings plans for public consultation.
