Other Ways of Knowing, Feeling, Thinking and Doing

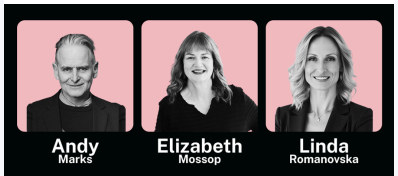

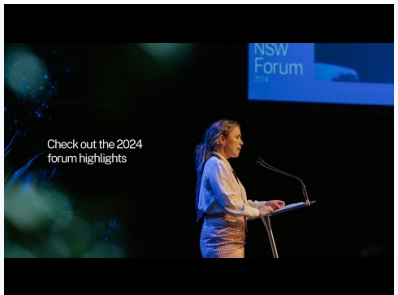

Last year's Forum was two days of thought-provoking conversation, memorable connections, and impactful insights. Relive the energy and inspiration from our time together by watching our highlights video.

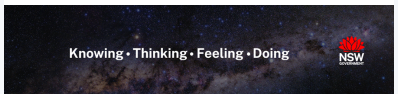
